

Cork is an extremely impressive and attractive material derived from the cork Oak tree's thick bark. They grow naturally in the Medit erranean region of Europe which produces 80% of the world's cork. Because of its impermeable, elastic and five retardant properties, it is used widely for sealing containers, fishing equipment and domestic applications. In ancient Greece, cork was used in foot wear to manufacture a type of sandals attached to the foot by straps. In the second century AD, Greek Physician Diascorids, noted several medical applications of cork, mainly for hair loss treatment. In musical instruments, particularly, wood wind instruments, it is used to fasten to together segments of the instruments.
